VENUE & SHOW INFORMATION

Entry Gates: There are two entry gates

- Entry Gate 1, located behind the Civic Theatre
- Entry Gate 2, located on the closed V8 track at the Ross Island end, off Boundary Street, near the corner of Railway Ave. Patrons holding a physical ticket can enter through either gate.

Box Office: (patrons collecting or purchasing tickets on the day) There are two box offices, one each located at Entry Gate 1 and Entry Gate 2 respectively. Complimentary tickets and pre-purchased tickets, on the day, can be collected from Box Office 1, located near Entry Gate 1. Patrons wanting to purchase tickets on the day can do so from Box Office 2, located near Entry Gate 2. Both box offices will open from 12 noon. Gates open at 1:00pm.

To avoid gueues on the day, patrons are encouraged to collect pre-purchased tickets by Friday (September 24th) from:

Disabled Access: Disabled access is via Entry Gate 2. Disabled parking is located at Little Reid Park, off Boundary Street

Pass-Outs: Pass-outs will not be available on the day. Once you have entered the venue, you will not be allowed re-entry if you decide to leave.

GETTING TO AND FROM THE EVENT

Recommended - BUS (\$5 FLAT FARE, VALID RETURN TRIP. APPLIES): Sunbus will operate special event Park-Ride services from suburban areas as well as their regular service routes. Special Event Park-Ride services will be available from The Strand, CBD, Willows via Stocklands and the University via Annandale and Bowen Road. Services commence at 12.30pm and run until 4.30pm Return services commence at 9.45pm.

ROUTE 1 Starting at The Strand, running the length of The Strand to the Rockpool, Seagulls, Bundock Street, Percy Street, Ingham Road, Venue. 3 services per hour

ROUTE 2 Starting in the Jupiters, Breakwater ferry terminal, CBD, Flinders Street West, Venue. – 4 services per hour.

ROUTE 4 Starting at JCU main stop, Annadale Shopping Centre, Walkabout Caravan Park, Bowen Road, Venue. – 3 services per hour.

ROUTE 5 Starting at The Willows Shopping Centre, Thurringowa Drive, Mill Drive, Fulham Road, Nathan Street, Stocklands Shopping Centre, Ross River Road, Venue. -1 service per hour.

Normal Sunbus services will operate as usual - routes 200, 201, 202, 203 & 204 will give you closest delivery point to the event. Patrons travelling by bus will be dropped north west of the Reid Park event site on Flinders Street West, around the Charters Towers Road Railway Station entrance.

Drop Off/Pick Up Point (including taxi's and buses): Bus, taxi and drop off and pick up points will be established north west of the venue on Flinders Street West, around the Charters Towers Road Railway Station entrance and track island area. Patrons can then walk to a safe closed pedestrian track (across the race track) for entry to Gate 1.

Parkina Facilities: Parkina, until at capacity, will be available at the

- following sites • Townsville High School - Access is via Boundary & First Streets.
- Lou Litster Park Access is via Brodie, Marks & Ford Street. • Disabled parking at Little Reid Park on the V8 Loop.
- VIP guest parking is located at Little Reid Park Chinese Club car park, located off Boundary Street between the Little Reid Park Disabled parking and the Townsville High School Car Park.

All parking facilities will be controlled by Townsville State High School P&C and Rotary. A charge of \$5 per vehicle will apply. One hundred per cent of all funds will go directly to these community groups. Venue access from all crparks is via safe crossings and tempoerary pedestrian crossings/thoroughferes. Limited parking available in

streets surrounding the venue. Parking is NOT permitted at the Civic Theatre.

Road Closures: From 12noon until 11pm on event day, Brodie Street between the intersection of Boundary Street and Charters Towers Road will become a one way street from Boundary Street onto Charters Towers Road to allow management of the Lou Litster car park. Traffic controllers and Police will man the street. At the conclusion of the event, Boundary Street (between Railway Avenue/Saunders Street and Charters Towers Road), will be closed for a period of up to 30 minutes (approx 9.45pm – 10.15pm) to allow safe patron egress. Traffic controllers and Police will man the closure
